

Did you know that in the US today 49 million people face hunger—that is 1 out of every

- 6 Americans. Here are some other facts about hunger:
- 1. More than 1 in 5 children are at risk of hunger.
- 2. For every 100 school lunch programs there are only 87 breakfast sites and just 36 summer food programs
- 3 The number of Americans going to food pantries and soup kitchens has risen by 46% since 2006.
- 4. More than 20 million children in the US rely on school meal programs to keep from going hungry.

When we think of hunger we often think about countries far away, but the reality is that many people are struggling to get enough to eat right here in our country, our state and even our own community. The La Porte County Association of REALTORS is sponsoring our 2nd Annual food

drive during the month of May to help our own community. Summer is approaching and many children that rely on meals at school may go hungry during the summer months. We are asking each office to collect nonperishable items during the month at your offices. At the end of May we will collect the donated items from your office to give to the local food pantries in our communities. Start collecting your items now to help us fill those pantries. Did you know that when clients move, they tend to throw away a lot of stuff,

unfortunately some of that stuff is food
