Continuing Education - April 27, 2016

A continuing education class has been added to our line-up in order to provide as much CE as possible to our members. All agents are required to take 12 hours of CE from July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016.

Here are some quick facts from the IPLA website:

- Brokers are required to complete 12 hours of CE every year from July 1st to June 30th.
- If your license status is ACTIVE or UNASSIGNED, you must complete the required CE to renew the license.
- If your license status is INACTIVE or REFERRAL, you are not required to complete CE to renew the license.
- If your license was issued on July 1, 2014 or after, you are required to complete the post-licensing education within 2 years of the date of issuance.
- Post-licensing education can be counted towards the required continuing education as outlined in 876 IAC 7-4-2.
- If you also hold the Managing Broker eligibility, 4 hours of the required 12 hours must be managing broker CE as outlined in 876 IAC 7-5-2.

If you also hold an instructor permit, 4 hours of the required 12 hours must be instructor specific CE as outlined in 876 IAC 7-5 -3.

LPCAR will offer <u>TRID</u> - 2 Credit Hours on April 27, 2016 from 1 -3 p.m. at the 1st Team U Training Room. Class size is limited to the first 25 registrations. Our instructor for the class will be Tim Reed. Please use the entrance located on the back side of the building. 1st Team U is located at 245 W Johnson Road in La Porte.

To register: please contact the Board Office at 219-324-8120 only. Due to the limited class size, we ask that you register by phone. Those attending must have/know their current RE license so please make sure you have that with you before arriving to the class. If you have any other questions, please contact the board office.
