




office space within the bank. My first home te with the association was located in the lower VINGS BANK level of the bank and I have great memories. Thanks so Much- You will be missed!

New Text Alert/Safety Alert Messaging System!!

October 1, 2016 - La Porte County Association of REALTORS®

The La Porte County Association of REALTORS® has launched a new text messaging system to keep our members up to date about important issues, events and news. It will also serve as a safety alert text-system that notifies members that an incident has occurred that may pose a threat to the safety and well-being of other REALTORS® in the area.

We hope with this new form of communication, members can stay on top of all the information not only from the local board, but from the state and national associations as well. As our cell phones become a more powerful resource, the distinction between texting and email is becoming less defined. Texts are delivered immediately and directly to a device that most of us have with us at all times. Not as many of us are checking email on such a regular basis -- even if someone owns a phone capable of sending and receiving email, there's no guarantee email is being checked as regularly as text messages. Text messages have more of a sense of urgency, whereas email tends to be seen as information that can be responded to at a later date. With cell numbers typically more closely guarded than email addresses, a text message also represents a more personal and intimate connection.

mobile text alerts

This system will allow any member to opt-in by signing up via this link: https://mobile-text-alerts.com/lpcar (members must opt-in/sign up...we will not add members with out their consent). Any member that has opted in may at any time opt-out by texting the word "Stop". Click on the image above to sign up - **Full name and phone number are required fields!**

We will continue to communicate via email, website and our social media outlets (Facebook/Twitter) but now members will have another option to receive important updates as well as be alerted to any potential safety threats or issues in our area. Many members have had issues recently not receiving email communications from the board, not being able to reply to emails received, or having the association emails blocked by their server. Each month, those subscribed will receive a message that the newsletter has been posted with a link to read the latest issue with information about upcoming meetings and/or events.

As with all text messaging systems, messages & data rates may apply depending on your provider and cell phone plan. (Expected amount of text messages = 2 to 4 messages/month)
